









ith the obvious benefit of a skylight-enhanced space, John and Victoria Skitt were keen to replace their existing kitchen with something that celebrated the abundance of natural light.

"We wanted to change the colour scheme and to create a lighter, more modern feel," reflects Victoria. "Our old kitchen, chosen by the previous owners, was quite dark with lots of dark wooden cabinets and had a peninsular rather than an island."

Higham Furniture was briefed to create a sleek design that combined modern with classic and ideally featured an island with French and industrial accents. "We met a number of designers at the beginning of our project but Higham was our preference from the start. We loved the Higham designs that we had seen online and we found the design team to be down-to-earth, engaged and flexible in approach from the beginning."

a little bit tired and the layout also did not work
well." The cabinetry chosen was a classic Shaker
style, featuring painted tulipwood and maple in
Little Greene French Grey-Pale and Scree. Using
the same Carrara quartz stone for the worktops
and splashback created a seamless look.

A couple of compromises had to be made along the way – all for the good of the design; for instance, the couple were keen to incorporate a range cooker, which presented a challenge as they had also wanted to keep a sofa area.

## THE designer



A separate utility room did away with the need for wall units on the main elevation, which enabled the room to celebrate the natural light coming in and a focal feature was made out of the new chimney, which houses an extractor. The couple decided on adding an urban touch into the mix of old and new.

"Our kitchen is a perfect combination of modern and classic design with sleek, clean lines. We have complemented the classic design with industrial touches such as the pendant lights and metal dining chairs," says Victoria.

"We love that the client went with clear, seethrough pendants above the island, as this lets all the focus be on the cabinetry, and it also complements the top glazed units," adds Veronika.
